

FWEA Southeast Chapter Scholarships for FAU Civil Engineering Students

The Southeast Chapter of the Florida Water Environment Association (FWEA) is awarding one or more scholarships to full-time (12 credits or more) FAU civil engineering students with more than 60 credit hours demonstrating an interest in water resources, water and wastewater treatment, and related fields.

Award

The goal is to award a minimum of \$1500 in scholarships each year. The exact nature of how many are awarded and at what level depends on the quality of the applicant pool and financial contribution budgeted by FWEA.

Selection Criteria

The award is based on merit and potential for contributions to the field and profession. The minimum acceptable grade point average is 3.2 for all college-level coursework. Participation in the FWEA student design competition is also a selection criteria for scholarship applicants. FAU will be participating in the annual competition starting this year. Applications will be ranked based on the following criteria:

Criteria	Points
Academic record (grade point average and strength of coursework)	40 points
Quality of recommendation letter	20 points
Statement of career goals and contributions	20 points
Participation in FWEA Student Design Competition	20 points
TOTAL	100 points

Judging Team

The FWEA Southeast Chapter Scholarship Committee will make the selection from applications received.

Application

The application will include full contact information, an unofficial transcript signed by student's faculty advisor or department chair, a letter of recommendation from the student's advisor or department chair, and a brief statement of career goals and what the student hopes to contribute to the fields of water resources, water and wastewater treatment, and related areas (approximately 1,000 words). The application must be sent to the FWEA Scholarship Committee and be postmarked by March 15 to be considered for an award to be made in the subsequent academic year. Decisions will be made by April 15, with the scholarship recipients notified by April 30. *(Note that for 2004 only, this submission deadline in June 30.)*
