**Appendix B: Social Science/Humanities Requirements (2007-2008)**

**Students entering FAU as freshman or transfer students with less than 30 credits**

Students in this category must complete the University Core Curriculum and thus select their Social Sciences/Humanities (SS/H) courses by the following criteria:

- Three courses (9 credits) from three different disciplines are selected from the Social Sciences list.
- Three courses (9 credits) are selected from the Humanities list. Of these three, two Gordon Rule courses (listed separately below) from two different disciplines are selected. Along with ENC 1101 and ENC 1102 (College Writing I and II) this will complete the Gordon Rule requirement for writing. The remaining course (3 credits) comes from the “Humanities (other)” list.

In addition, the Department of Civil Engineering requires that at least two SS/H courses have a global or “world” perspective (denoted with a W below).
