Scholarships for Latin American and Caribbean Engineering Students

Florida Atlantic University is a founding member of the Latin American and Caribbean Consortium of Engineering Institutions, and has established scholarships for international students who are citizens of Latin America and the Caribbean (including Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands). In order to qualify, students must be fully admissible to FAU under existing criteria for graduate programs and meet other standards:

- Complete FAU admissions form and pay its application fee prior to applying for this scholarship (see <http://www.fau.edu/academic/gradstud/grad.htm>)
- A minimum of 3.0/4.0 GPA.
- GRE and TOEFL scores required by the program to which student is applying
- Full time status, 9 credits per semester for graduate students during Fall and Spring semesters and 6 credits in the Summer semester, is required.
- The applicant seeking a Master's must be in the thesis option with the goal of continuing to pursue a PhD.

The award is an established scholarship that is offered on the basis of existing policies and guidelines, and the selection process is open and competitive. Details of the LACCEI scholarship are as follows:

- The College commits to financial support for the duration of the student's degree program, as long as the student remains a full-time student in good standing.
- The minimum amount of a LACCEI Scholarship is \$500 per year (\$250 paid Fall semester, \$250 paid Spring Semester).
- Student would be considered Florida residents for tuition purposes under the provisions of Section 1009.21 (10) (e) of the Florida Statutes. In 2004, tuition costs for Florida Residents is \$232.10 per credit vs. \$869.48 per credit for Non-Residents, representing a savings of approximately \$15,300 a year in tuition cost.
